Personal data collected will be limited to what is necessary for the specified purpose.

4. Legal Basis of Collection and Processing

VISL-IOB processes personal data on one or more of the following legal bases:

- Consent provided by the Data Principal.
- Performance of contractual obligations.
- Compliance with legal and regulatory requirements.
- Employment and recruitment-related requirements.
- Protection of legitimate business interests, including security, fraud prevention, risk management, and business operations.
- Other lawful grounds permitted under applicable data protection laws.

Where consent is relied upon, you may withdraw your consent at any time, subject to applicable legal and contractual obligations.

5. Recipients or Categories of Recipients of Personal Data

VISL-IOB may share personal data with:

- Recruitment agencies and background verification agencies.
- Consultants, auditors, legal advisors, insurers, and professional service providers.

- Other third parties where disclosure is required by law or necessary for legitimate business purposes.

All such recipients are obligated to maintain appropriate confidentiality, security, and data protection safeguards.

6. Transfer to Third Countries

VISL-IOB may transfer, store, access, or process personal data outside India where necessary for:
